RECITALS:

- 1. The property encumbered by this Policy is that property restricted by the Restrictions for Lake Conroe Hills, Section I, which is recorded in the Official Public Records of Real Property of Montgomery County, Texas in Clerk's File No. 305997, as same has been or may be amended from time to time ("Declaration"), and any other property which has been or may be subsequently annexed thereto and made subject to the authority of the Association.
- 2. Section 551.403 of the Texas Transportation Code (the "Code") gives owners and residents certain statutory rights to operate golf carts without a license plate in certain master planned communities.
- 3. Lake Conroe Hills is a master planned community that is a residential subdivision under Section 209.002(9) of the Texas Property Code located in Montgomery County, Texas.
 - 4. The Board desires to adopt an operation of golf carts policy consistent with the provisions of Section 551.403 of the Code even though the Association's streets are private.
 - 5. This Policy replaces and supersedes any previously recorded or implemented policy that addresses the subjects contained herein, if any, adopted by the Association.

POLICY:

It is the policy of the Association to allow golf carts to be operated in the Lake Conroe Hills subdivision subject to the following rules and regulations:

1. **Definition**. As used herein, "golf cart" means a motor vehicle designed by the manufacturer primarily for use on a golf course.

- 2. Speed. During the daytime, a golf cart may not be operated at a speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour. At night, a golf cart may not be operated at a speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
- 3. Equipment. A golf cart must have functioning headlamps, tail lamps, reflectors, parking brake, and mirrors. A golf cart is not required to have golf cart license plate.
- 4. Parking. A golf cart may not be parked on a private street.
- 5. Conduct. A golf cart must be operated in accordance with the following:
 - a. A person operating a golf cart must yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian.
 - b. The driver and passengers, if any, in a golf cart must be seated at all times during which the golf cart is in motion. No person may sit in the driver's lap when a golf cart is in motion.
 - c. The number of seated passengers in a golf cart may not exceed the number of passengers for which the golf cart was designed.
 - d. The driver and passengers, if any, must keep their arms and legs within the golf cart, meaning within the width and length of the golf cart.
 - e. The operator of a golf cart may not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
 - f. An operator of a golf cart who is sixteen (16) years of age or older is not required to have a valid driver's license.
 - g. If the operator of a golf cart is fifteen (15) years old, the operator must have a valid learners permit in his/her possession. If the operator of the golf cart is fifteen (15) years old but does not have a valid learners permit, the operator must be accompanied in the front seat by a parent, grandparent, legal guardian, or a person eighteen (18) years of age or older who has a valid driver's license.
 - h. If the operator of a golf cart is twelve (12), thirteen (13) or fourteen (14) years old, the operator must be accompanied in the front seat by a parent, grandparent, or legal guardian.
 - i. No person under twelve (12) years of age may operate a golf cart in the subdivision.

I hereby certify that I am the duly elected, qualified and acting President of the Association and that the foregoing Policy Relating to the Use of Golf Carts in the community was approved by the vote of the Board of Directors of the Association as set forth above and now appears in the books and records of the Association.


